VINTAGE 1982

A wet winter and a warm spring produced perfect bloom and berry set and a record crop for the 1982 vintage. Cabernet Sauvignon and related varietals weathered the mid-September rains quite well, producing full-bodied wines requiring a decade or more of bottle aging.
